

RANGE RULES



SAFETY

- Keep arrows pointed down range. Never point a bow and arrow at another person.
- Shoot only at designated targets.
- Straddle the shooting line. Keep one foot in front and one foot behind the line.
- Dropped arrows. If you cannot reach your arrow from the shooting line.
- No arrow is to be nocked while another person is down range.
- Leave your bow at the shooting line while retrieving your arrows.
- Walk, don't run to the target.
- Removing arrows. Only one person at a time should remove arrows from the target.
- Persons under the influence. Anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol is prohibited from shooting.
- Check your equipment often. Nicked arrows can result in serious injury to you and others.
- Never dry fire a bow. Doing so may damage the equipment and could result in injury to you and others.
- Report any unsafe or dangerous acts to the pro-staff.

SHOOTING ETIQUETTE

- Step back from the shooting line when done shooting. This lets others know that you are done.
- Confirm that shooting has stopped by making eye contact with other shooters and then say loudly, "CLEAR" before proceeding down range to retrieve arrows.
- Be courteous to other shooters and avoid distractions while shooting. Profanity is discouraged.
- No more than six (6) arrows may be shot before the arrows are retrieved.

SPECTATOR ETIQUETTE

- Spectators should remain behind the glass windows and outside the shooting rooms.
- Please observe in silence and avoid making distractions when archers are shooting.
- La Crosse Archery welcomes the exposure of children to the archery experience; however, for their safety children must be under the strict control of a parent or guardian at all times. Silence when archers are on the fire line applies to children as well as adults.

HOUSE RULES

- NO BROADHEADS unless specifically designated broadhead butts are available on the range. If you are not sure which bales can be shot at with broadheads please ask our pro-staff for clarification.
- Field tips and target points only are to be shot into target butts.
- Put trash in its place. Help us keep this facility clean and neat for all who use it.
- A list of safety rules could never address all situations. Users of this range are expected to be safety conscious and responsible at all times. Any questions regarding these rules should be asked of the pro-shop employee on duty.
- Please position targets on lower and upper half of the target butt. This will extend the life of the butt.
