

# La Crosse Archery Scramble Elite Hunter

## \$50 per team

### **PAY-OUT BREAKDOWN:**

*20 Teams will pay out \$700 for 1st Place / \$200 for 2nd Place / \$100 for 3rd Place if 20 teams participate*

### **PRACTICE:**

- Hunters course practice starts an hour prior to shoot

### **MAIN ROUND:**

- First 20 teams registered & paid will shoot a 20 Target 3D course
- Those who shoot the hunter class may also shoot the elite tournament
- Shooters choosing to shoot both must follow the equipment rules.
- Rangefinders approved, marked distance
- ASA Style (with OPA twist) low 12's, rear vitals are in play for targets marked
- Two-Man teams, first qualification round best arrow counts.
- One arrow will be scored in this round, but if both partners shoot a 12, this will equal a team 13

### **TRANSITION FROM MAIN ROUND TO SHOOT-OFF**

- Cumulative scores from main round, top 5 scores enter the shoot-off

### **SHOOT-OFF**

- cumulative scores do apply in this format.
- One minute per shooter, with an extra 15 seconds per archer to decide and call the 14 Judge.
- Both arrows count in the shoot-off
- Low 12's will be scored
- 14's will be in play in the shoot-off – *but each shooter must call his 14 to a judge prior to shooting – the 12 goes away if the 14 is called*
- Running team scores will be recorded for all to see
- As many targets will be shot as many teams are in the shoot off

### **EQUIPMENT RESTRICTIONS - DETAILS**

- *Arrows:* 23/64 or smaller arrow diameter  
5 grains per pound or more
- *Sight:* no scope glass in sight
- Moving single or multiple pin sights are approved
- Peep sight clarifier or verifier approved
- *Stabilizers:* 14" off the back and front, 14 front 14 rear. They will be measured from the start of the stabilizer bushing to the end of the object.
